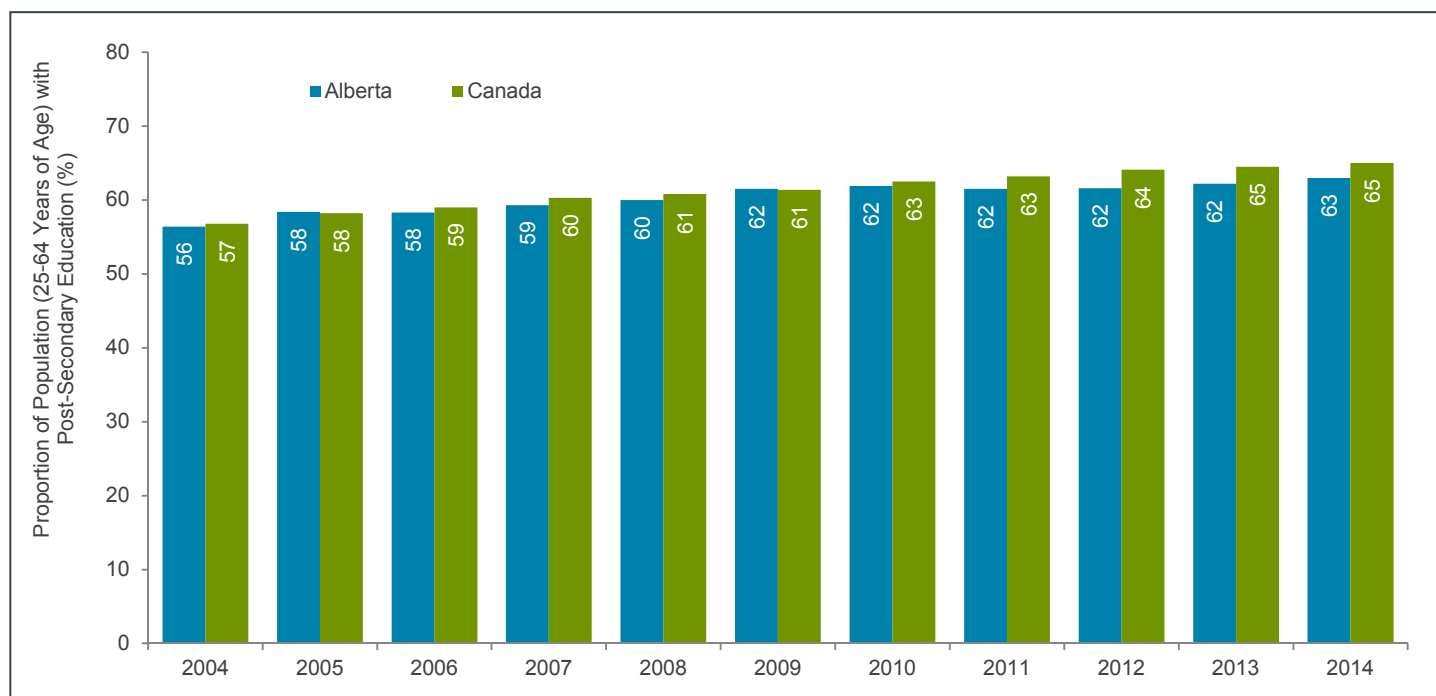
## Proportion of Population Aged 25-64 with Post-Secondary Education, Alberta and Canada

- The proportion of Albertans with post-secondary credentials<sup>1</sup> has followed a generally increasing trend since 2004.
- In 2014, 63% of Albertans aged 25-64 had completed post-secondary studies, compared to 56% in 2004.
- In 2014, the proportion of Albertans aged 25-64 with a post-secondary education, 63%, remained slightly below the national average, which was 65%.

<sup>1</sup> Post-secondary credentials include: bachelor's degrees, degrees or certificates above a bachelor's degree, university certificates below bachelor's degree, trades certificates or diplomas from vocational or apprenticeship training, and non-university certificates or diplomas issued by a community college.
