

## STUDENT EVALUATION REGULATION REMUNERATION SCHEDULE

### Section 1

In accordance with section 13(1) of the *Student Evaluation Regulation*, Alberta Regulation 177/2003, the following remuneration schedule shall apply to individuals providing service, under clause (b) to Provincial Assessment, Alberta Education, effective January 1, 2019.

(i) **Honorarium For Centralized Standards Confirmation and/or Standards Setting:**

Operating/Non-Operating Day	Operating/Non-Operating Half Day
\$200	\$100

(ii) **Honorarium For Centralized Scoring, Marking, Reads, Exemplar Selection or Rescoring:**

Operating/Non-Operating Day	Operating/Non-Operating Half Day
\$200	\$100

- For the purpose of marker remuneration, an “operating day” is any weekday, excluding statutory holidays, between September 1 and June 30 or between September 1 to June 29 when June 30 is a Monday.

(iii) **Subsistence and travel allowances shall be paid to Alberta individuals providing services under (i) or (ii) in accordance with the following schedule:**

	Allowance
Travel (home to city centre, return)	50.5 cents per km (Minimum \$40/day)
Subsistence (accommodation, breakfast, supper)	\$150/day (Must live more than 70 km from marking city centre and require accommodations)

- The individual must incur the expense to claim the allowance.

(iv) **Subsistence allowance shall be paid to non-Alberta individuals providing services under (i) or (ii) in accordance with the following schedule:**

	Allowance
Subsistence (accommodation, breakfast, supper)	\$150/day (Must live more than 70 km from marking city centre and require accommodations)

- The individual must incur the expense to claim the allowance.

(v) In accordance with section 13(2) of the *Student Evaluation Regulation*, Alberta Regulation 177/2003, if a substitute teacher is required while a teacher is providing services under Section 13(1) substitute teacher costs will be paid to school authorities in accordance with each individual school authority’s collective agreement.

## Section 2

In accordance with section 13(1) of the *Student Evaluation Regulation*, Alberta Regulation 177/2003, the following remuneration schedule shall apply to individuals providing service, under clause (a), (c) or (d), to Provincial Assessment, Alberta Education, effective January 1, 2019.

- (i) **Supervising the administration of Provincial Assessment evaluation materials and provincially designated Diploma Exam writing centres:**

- (ii) **Designing and preparing evaluation materials:** \$30.00/hour
- (iii) **Subsistence allowance and travel allowance** shall be paid to individuals providing services under above bullets (i) and (ii) in accordance with the *Travel, Meal and Hospitality Expenses Directive #1/2015* pursuant to the *Financial Administration Act*.
- (iv) In accordance with section 13(2) of the *Student Evaluation Regulation*, Alberta Regulation 177/2003, if a substitute teacher is required while a teacher is providing services under Section 13(1) substitute teacher costs will be paid to school authorities in accordance with each individual school authority's collective agreement

Pursuant to Section 9, *Government Organization Act*, the Executive Director, Provincial Assessment, is authorized to adjust this fee schedule in individual cases due to exceptional circumstances.
