# COVID-19 RESIDENT SCREENING TOOL

For all licensed supportive living, long-term care and hospices.

## Overview

If a resident answers **YES** to any of the questions, they must follow the direction given.

<b>1.</b>	<b>Have you traveled outside Canada in the last 14 days?</b>	<b>YES</b>	<b>NO</b>
<p><b>If you answered “YES”:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The resident must immediately be given a <b>procedure/surgical mask</b> and <b>quarantined</b> in their room for 14 days from entry to Canada.</li> <li>If the resident develops any symptoms, they should be offered testing for COVID-19.</li> </ul> <p><b>If you answered “NO”, proceed to question 2.</b></p>			
<b>2.</b>	<b>Have you had close contact<sup>1</sup> with a case<sup>2</sup> of COVID-19 in the last 14 days?</b>	<b>YES</b>	<b>NO</b>
<p><b>If you answered “YES”:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The resident must immediately be given a <b>procedure/surgical mask</b> and <b>quarantined</b> in their room for 14 days except:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Previously tested positive for COVID-19 in last 90 days before exposure:                   <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No quarantine required. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Fully immunized<sup>3</sup> against COVID-19:                   <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No quarantine required. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Partially immunized<sup>4</sup> against COVID-19:                   <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Quarantine for 10 days. If tested on day 7 or later after exposure, quarantine ends after receiving a negative test result.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>If you answered “NO” or if you have symptoms, proceed to question 3.</b></p>			
<b>3.</b>	<b>Do you have any new onset (or worsening) of the following symptoms:</b>		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fever</li> <li>Cough</li> <li>Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing</li> <li>Runny nose</li> <li>Sore throat</li> <li>Chills</li> <li>Painful/difficult swallowing</li> <li>Nasal congestion/stuffy nose</li> <li>Feeling unwell / fatigued / severe exhaustion</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nausea / vomiting / diarrhea</li> <li>Unexplained loss of appetite</li> <li>Loss of sense of taste or smell</li> <li>Muscle / joint aches</li> <li>Headache</li> <li>Conjunctivitis (pink eye)</li> <li>Sneezing</li> <li>Altered mental status</li> </ul>	<b>YES</b>
			<b>NO</b>
<p><b>If you answered “YES” to any symptom in question 3:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The resident must immediately be given a <b>procedure/surgical mask</b> and <b>isolated</b> in their room and should be asked to consent to testing for COVID-19.</li> </ul>			

<sup>1</sup> Face-to-face contact within 2 metres.

<sup>2</sup> A lab-confirmed case OR a probable case as defined in the [Alberta COVID-19 Notifiable Disease Guideline](#)

<sup>3</sup> Fully-immunized = 14 days after receiving the second dose of a two-dose vaccine series OR 14 days after receiving one dose of a one-dose vaccine series.

<sup>4</sup> Partially-immunized = 14 days after receiving the first dose of a two-dose vaccine series
