COVID-19 RESIDENT SCREENING TOOL

For all licensed supportive living, long-term care and hospices.

Overview

If a resident answers **YES** to any of the questions, they must follow the direction given.

1.	Have you traveled outside Canada in the last 14 days?	YES	NO
<p>If you answered “YES”:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The resident must immediately be given a procedure/surgical mask and quarantined in their room for 14 days from entry to Canada. If the resident develops any symptoms, they should be offered testing for COVID-19. <p>If you answered “NO”, proceed to question 2.</p>			
2.	Have you had close contact¹ with a case² of COVID-19 in the last 14 days?	YES	NO
<p>If you answered “YES”:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The resident must immediately be given a procedure/surgical mask and quarantined in their room for 14 days except: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Previously tested positive for COVID-19 in last 90 days before exposure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No quarantine required. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days. Fully immunized³ against COVID-19: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No quarantine required. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days. Partially immunized⁴ against COVID-19: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quarantine for 10 days. If tested on day 7 or later after exposure, quarantine ends after receiving a negative test result. <p>If you answered “NO” or if you have symptoms, proceed to question 3.</p>			
3.	Do you have any new onset (or worsening) of the following symptoms:		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fever Cough Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing Runny nose Sore throat Chills Painful/difficult swallowing Nasal congestion/stuffy nose Feeling unwell / fatigued / severe exhaustion 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nausea / vomiting / diarrhea Unexplained loss of appetite Loss of sense of taste or smell Muscle / joint aches Headache Conjunctivitis (pink eye) Sneezing Altered mental status 	YES

<p>If you answered “YES” to any symptom in question 3:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The resident must immediately be given a procedure/surgical mask and isolated in their room and should be asked to consent to testing for COVID-19.

² A lab-confirmed case OR a probable case as defined in the [Alberta COVID-19 Notifiable Disease Guideline](#)

³ Fully-immunized = 14 days after receiving the second dose of a two-dose vaccine series OR 14 days after receiving one dose of a one-dose vaccine series.

⁴ Partially-immunized = 14 days after receiving the first dose of a two-dose vaccine series
