Year (May 1-April 30) – the timber year.

Clearcutting (ha) – total area (in hectares) where the harvesting method in a given timber year involved the harvesting of all merchantable trees in a single operation.

Partial-cut, seed tree and shelterwood (ha) – total area (in hectares) where the harvesting method in a given timber year involved one of the following methods: harvesting of varying proportions of mature trees in a forest; clearcutting but leaving evenly spaced mature trees as a source of seeds for natural regeneration; or removing mature trees with commercial value in a series of operations.

Commercial thinning (ha) – total area (in hectares) where the harvest method for a given timber year involved harvesting trees based on size, height and species to enhance the growing conditions for the remaining trees.

Total area harvested (ha)- the total area (in hectares) of all harvesting methods in Alberta in a given timber year.

Preliminary (p) – numbers reported for the first time in the Sutainable Forest Management: Current Facts & Statistics. This usually applies to the most recent reporting year of each statistic.

Revised (r) – numbers previously reported in the Sustainable Forest Management: Current Facts & Statistics that have been updated since last reporting.
