Public Lands Rents and Other Amounts Payable Amendment Order

APPENDIX

Public Lands Rents and Other Amounts Payable Amendment Order

- 1 The Public Lands Rents and Other Amounts Payable Order (MO 28/2015) is amended by this Order.
- 2 Section 1 is amended
 - a. by adding the following after subsection (6)

(7) The fee is \$1,800 for an application for a Lease for Tourism and Commercial Recreation Purposes.
- 3 The following is added after section 26:
 - 27 The rents payable for public land activity under a Lease for Tourism and Commercial Recreation Purposes are as follows:
 - (1) For a disposition issued to a non-profit organization or society, incorporated under the Societies Act, or a municipality (including municipal corporations) or an improvement district, \$100 or \$10 per acre lump sum, whichever is greater.
 - (2) For a disposition issued to organizations or persons not provided for in 27(1)
 - a. \$400 per year for areas less than one acre,
 - b. an additional \$50 per acre per year for areas one to five acres,
 - c. an additional \$10 per acre per year for areas over five acres, and
 - d. 6% of appraised value per year for the use of buildings, sites and improvements.
 - (3) For a disposition issued within Incorporated Urban Centres, Bow Corridor and the Kananaskis Improvement District
 - a. 2% per year of appraised land value, with a minimum rent of \$400 per year, and
 - b. 6% of appraised value of per year for use of buildings, sites and improvements.
