# Introduction

The Alberta Teaching Profession Commission is committed to transparency and fairness in the handling of competency and conduct complaints about teachers or teacher leaders. The following update provides information on the number of complaints about teachers or teacher leaders in the first quarter (Q1) of the 2024/25 fiscal year and the commission's activities during this time period.

### **New complaints**

## **Transition reports**

A total of 6 transition reports from the Registrar were provided to the Alberta Teaching Profession Commission in Q1.

# **Decisions following preliminary inquiry**

In the first quarter, a total of 56 decisions after preliminary inquiry were made. Of those decisions, 70 per cent were referred to investigation, 23 per cent were dismissed and 7 per cent were referred to a resolution process.

In the first quarter, a total of 12 decisions after a resolution process were made. Of those decisions, 100 per cent were resolved.

In the first quarter, a total of 48 decisions after investigation were made. Of these decisions, 19 per cent were referred to hearing, 62 per cent were dismissed and 19 per cent were referred to a resolution process.

#### Summary of decisions

In total, the commissioner issued 116 decisions in the first quarter. Fifty-five complaints were resolved (30 after investigation, 12 after a resolution process and 13 after preliminary inquiry). There were no complaints withdrawn in this time period.
