


Alberta exported \$80.6 billion worth of goods in 2007, up 3.7% from the previous record of \$77.7 billion in 2006.

Non-energy exports were worth \$25.7 billion, increasing 8.0% from 2006. Energy exports were worth \$54.9 billion, up 1.8%

Alberta was the second largest provincial exporter, behind Ontario, accounting for 19% of Canada's total exports in 2007.








