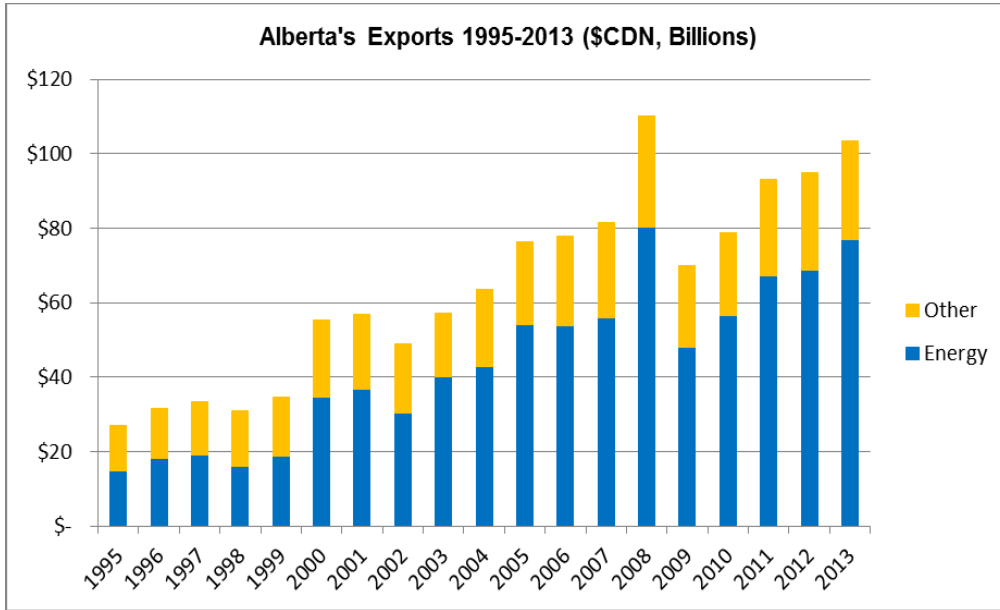


ALBERTA'S EXPORTS IN 2013



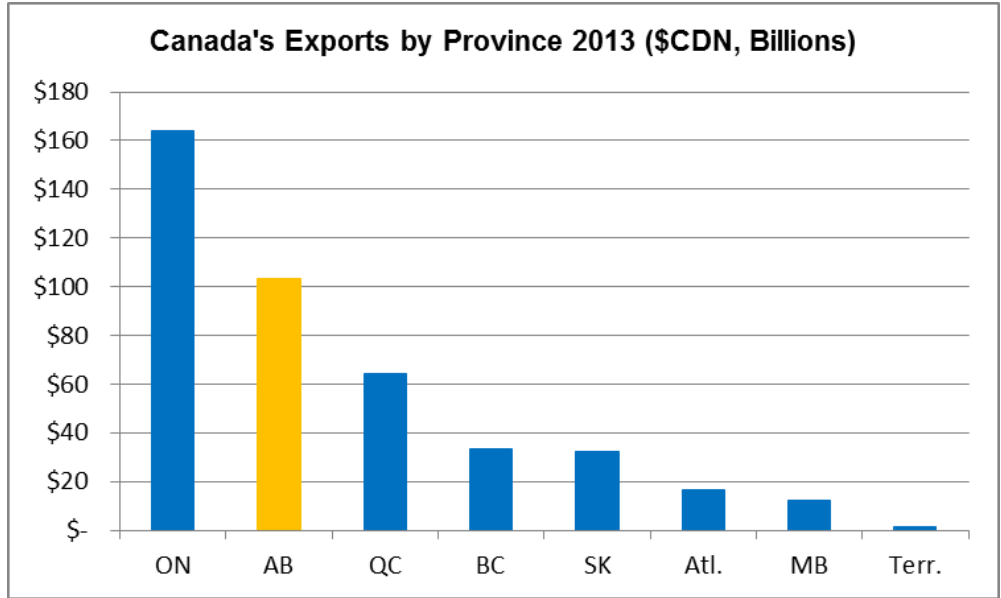
Alberta exported \$103.3 billion worth of goods in 2013, up 7.7% from 2012. Alberta's exports in 2013 were the second highest dollar value on record.

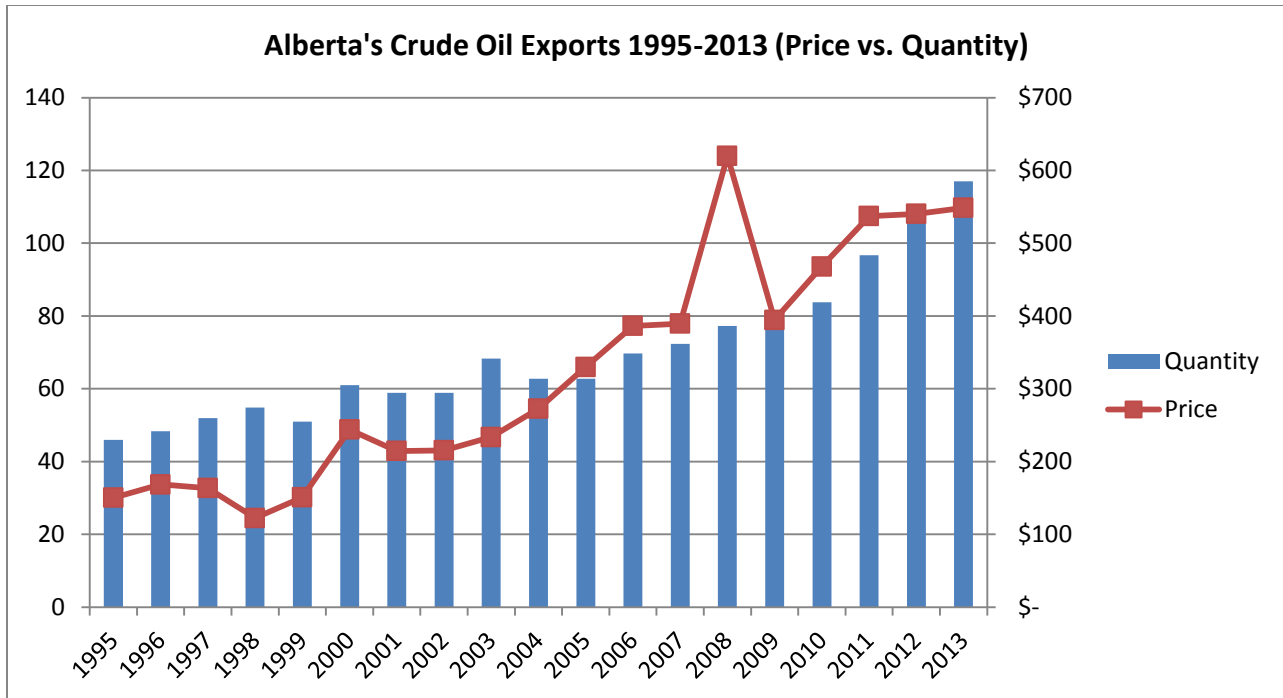
Energy exports also saw increases of 10.2%, increasing from \$69.3 billion in 2012 to \$76.8 billion in 2013.

Non-energy exports remained relatively constant during this period, increasing 1.0% from \$26.2 billion to \$26.4 billion

Alberta was the second largest provincial exporter in 2013, behind Ontario and ahead of Quebec. Alberta accounted for 23.3% of Canada's exports of goods in 2013.

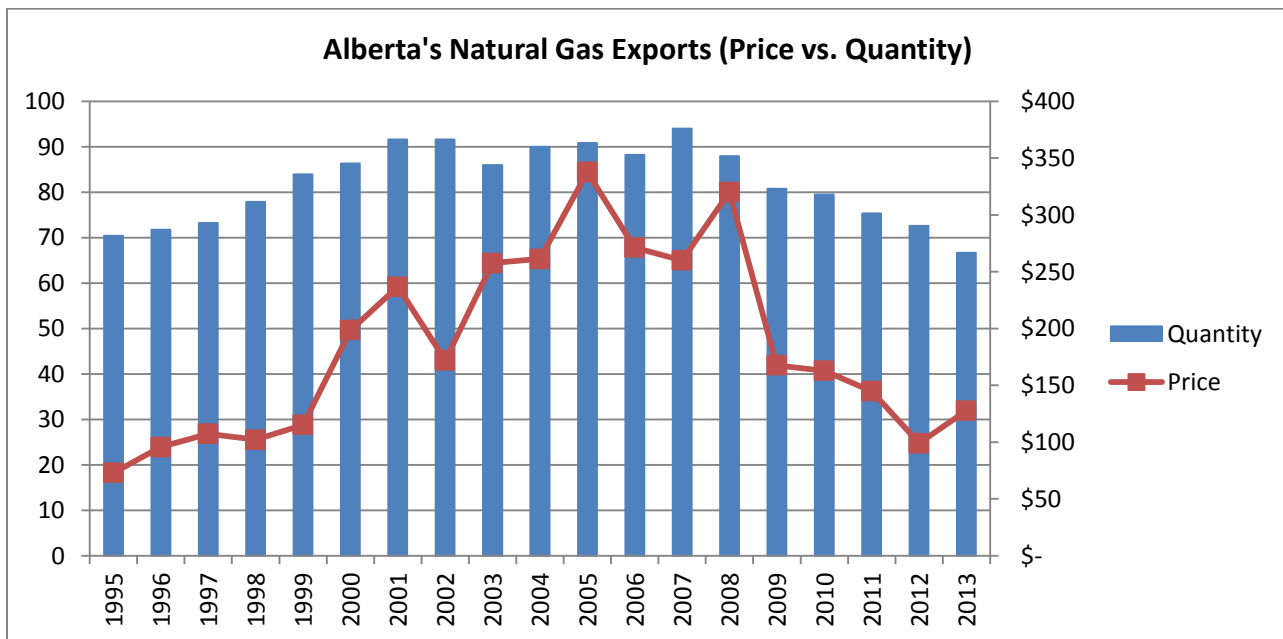
Canada exported a total of \$443.1 billion in 2013, an increase of 3.6% from 2012.





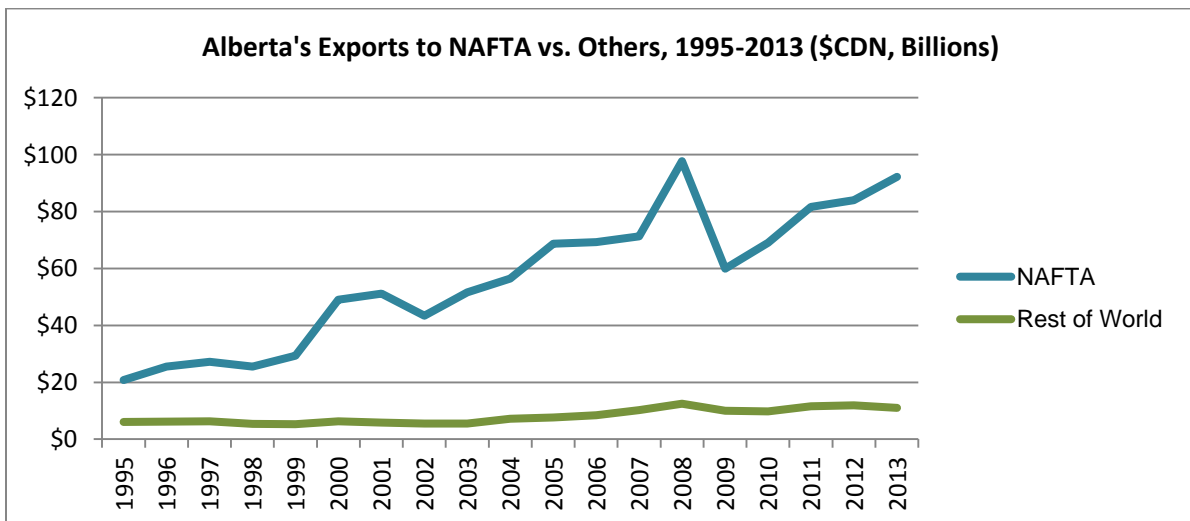
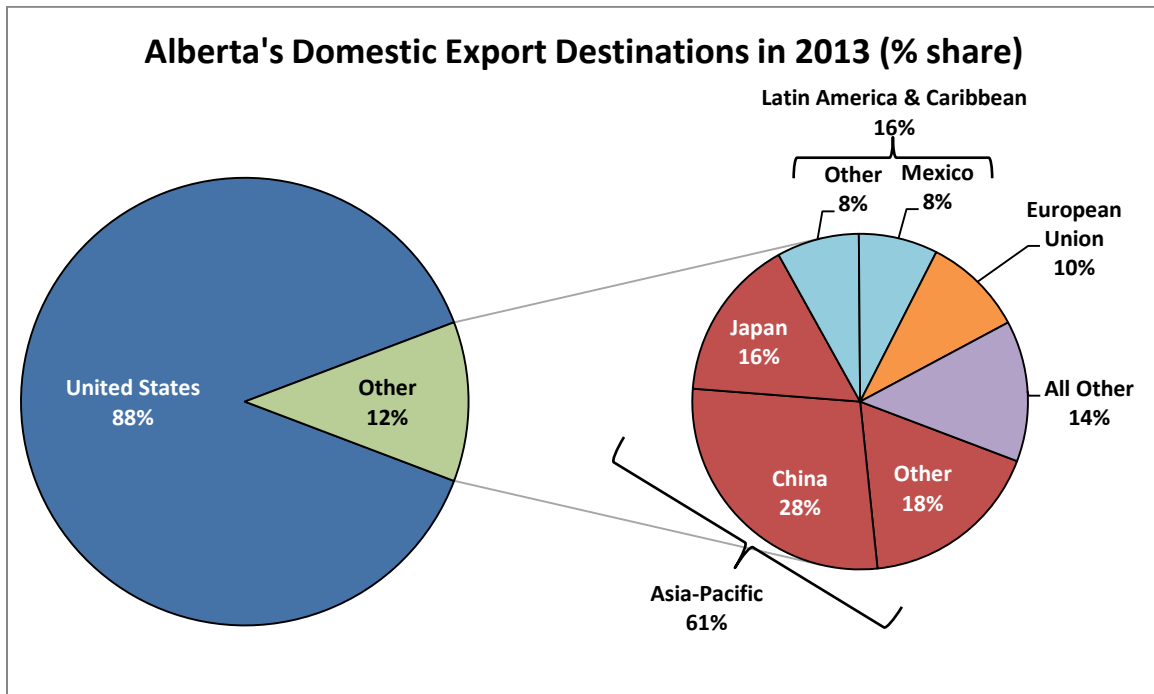
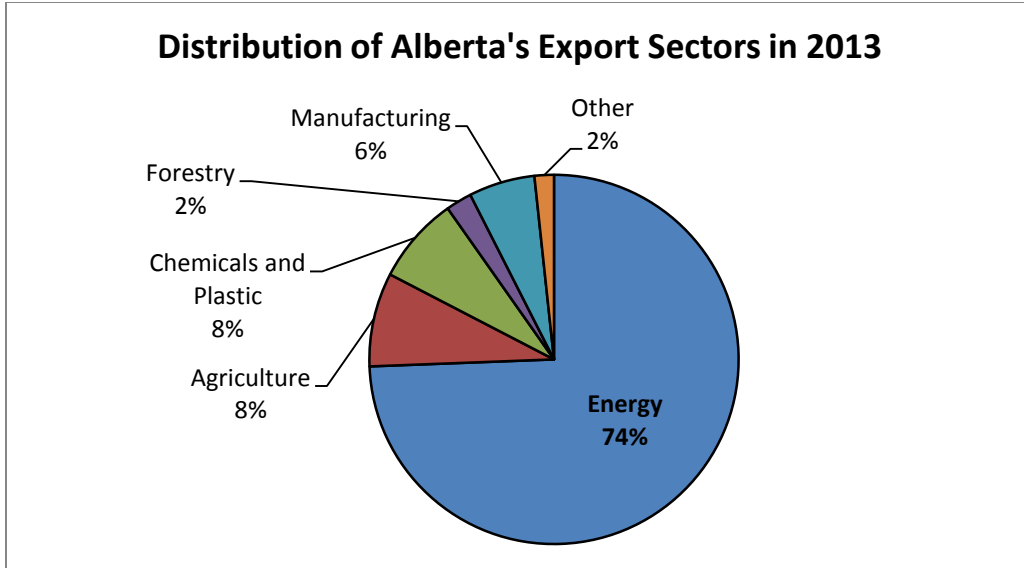
Alberta exported a total of \$64.2 billion worth of crude oil in 2013, up 10.8% from 2012. The price of crude oil exports increased marginally at a rate of 1.6% from 2012 to 2013, while the volume of oil increased 9.1% during the same period. Note that the price is the average for 2013 and disguises variations throughout the year.

Natural gas exports from Alberta totaled \$8.5 billion in 2013, an increase of 18.5% from 2012. The price of natural gas exports increased 29.1% from 2012 to 2013. The volume of natural gas exports however, decreased 8.2% during the same time period.
