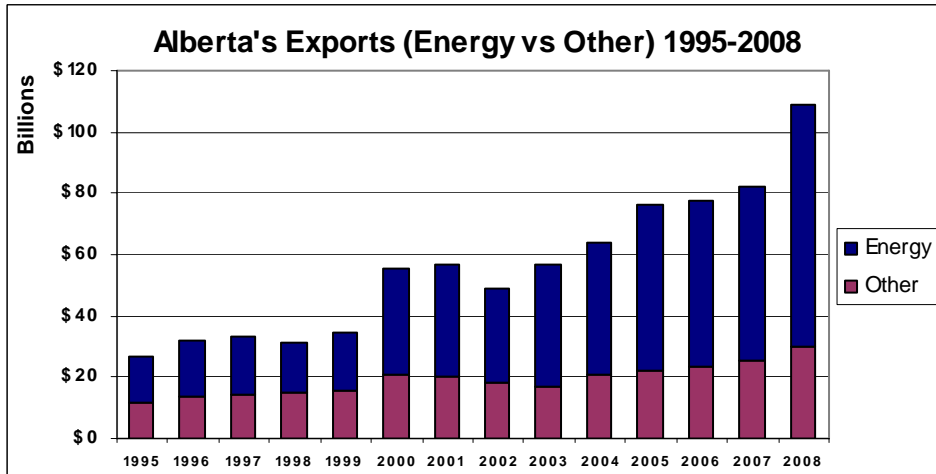


# Fact Sheet: Alberta's Exports in 2008



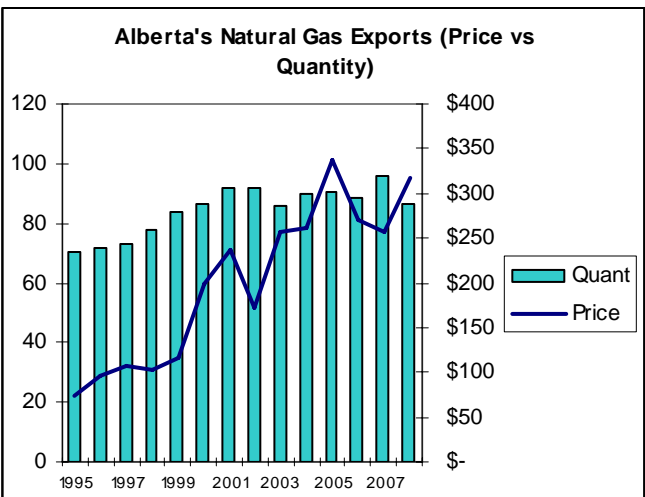
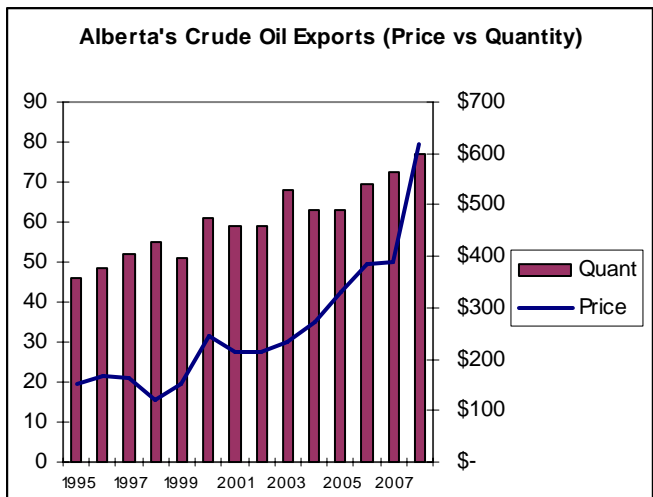
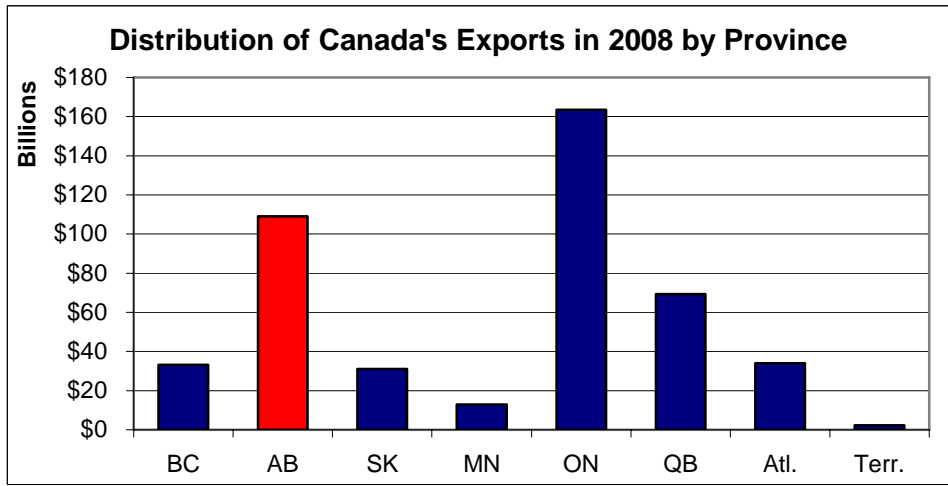
Alberta exported \$109.0 billion worth of goods in 2008, up 33.2% from the previous record of \$81.9 billion in 2007.

Increased energy prices accounted for much of these gains. Energy exports rose 40.8% to \$79.3 billion (from \$56.3 billion in 2007).

Non-energy exports also increased significantly, by 16.4% to \$29.8 billion (from \$25.6 billion in 2007).

Alberta was the second largest provincial exporter, behind Ontario, accounting for 24.0% of Canada's total exports in 2008.

Canada as a whole exported \$455.1 billion worth of goods in 2008, an increase of 8.3% from 2007 exports.



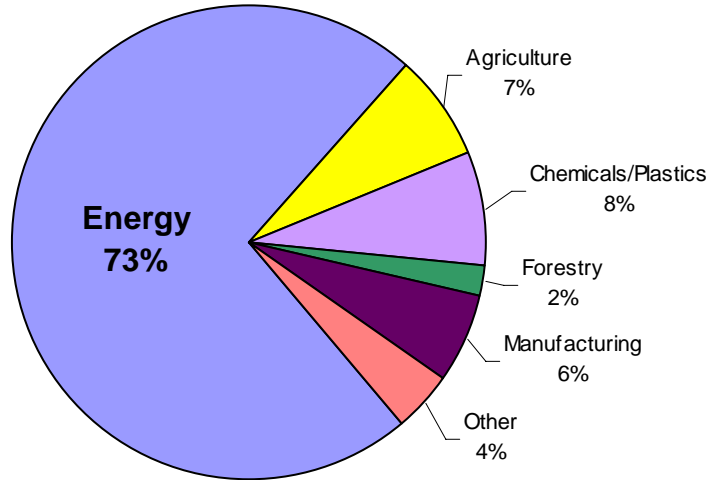
From 2007 to 2008, the quantity of crude oil exported by Alberta increased 6.4% while the average price received for these exports increased by 59.2%, resulting in a 69.4% increase in the value of exports, to \$47.8 billion from \$28.2 billion in 2007. Note that the price is the average for 2008 and disguises large variations over the course of the year.

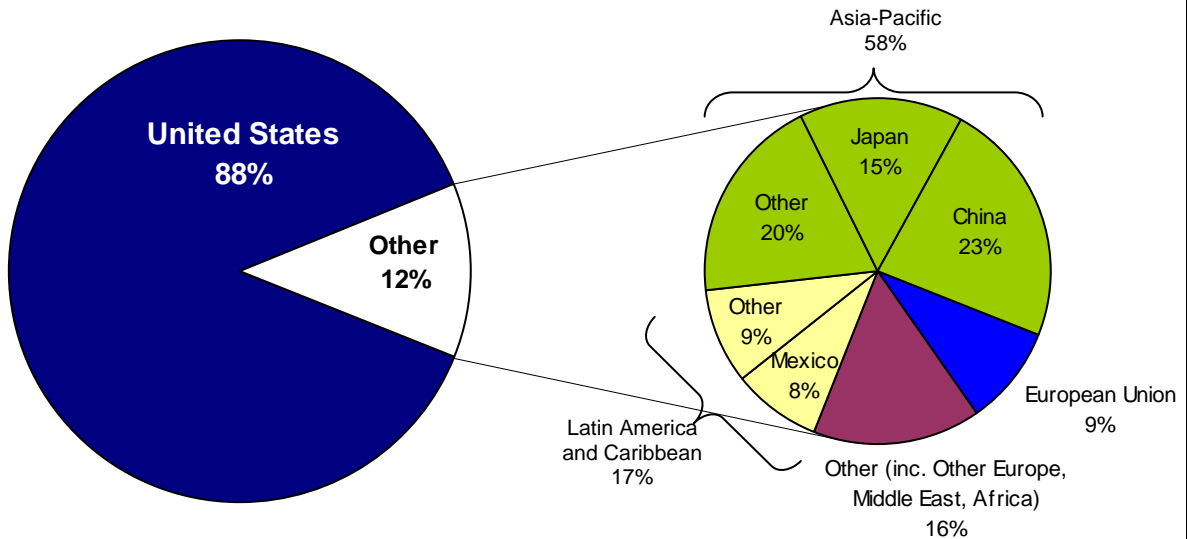
While the quantity of natural gas exported by Alberta in 2008 declined by 9.9% from 2007, this was more than compensated for by a 22.6% increase in the average price obtained for those exports, which resulted in a 10.5% rise in the value of Alberta's natural gas exports to \$27.3 billion in 2008.

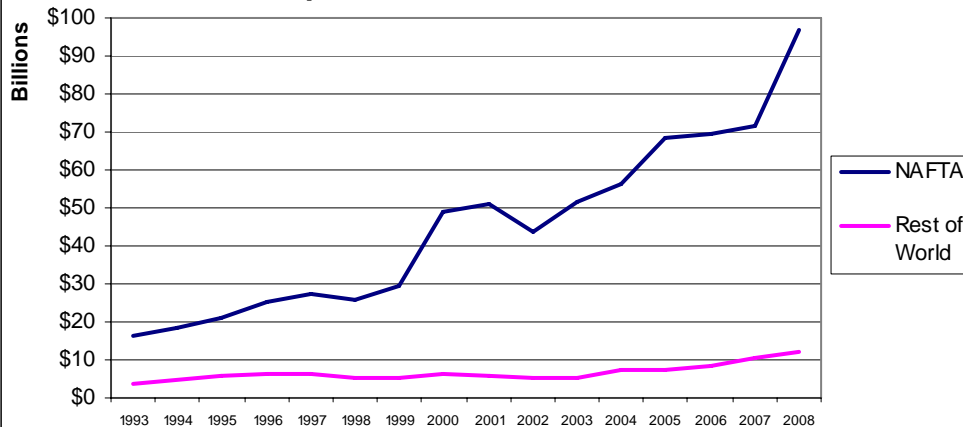
### Distribution of Alberta's Export Sectors in 2008

### Alberta's Exports to NAFTA vs Others 1993-2008



Since 1993, the year before the implementation of the NAFTA, Alberta's export to NAFTA (the US and Mexico) have increased by 502% compared to an increase of 235% for exports to the rest of the world.
