### Update for Medical Surgical Vendors and Authorizers

#### Notification of Amendment

Effective October 1, 2016, the Minister will implement the following changes to Schedule A of the Medical Surgical Agreements between AADL and a small number of medical surgical vendors (“Agreements”). AADL has already contacted the vendors that are impacted by these changes and copies of the amendment have been sent to them.

#### Addition of Large Bathing and Toileting Aids

The product range for large bathing and toileting aids will be amalgamated into the list of Benefit Groups contained in Schedule A of the Agreements.

#### Trained Provider Qualifications

Schedule A no longer references the Trained Provider qualifications contained in the AADL Program Manual and Approved Product List. Because the Trained Provider qualifications contained in the AADL Program Manual and Approved Product List are amended from time to time, Schedule A has been changed to allow for the flexibility required to adapt to these amendments. The Trained Provider qualifications were most recently amended in the AADL Program Manual and Approved Product List on October 1, 2016.
