Seating Approved Product List (APL) Update

To All Seating Authorizers and Vendors:

Effective April 1, 2014 the following changes have been made to the Seating APL at http://www.health.alberta.ca/documents/AADL-Manual-X-Products.pdf:

- All commercially available complete seating systems now fall under a single generic catalogue number. A generic catalogue number for pediatric seating has been added with a quantity and frequency of one per two years rather than one per four years.
- ◆ Manufacturers who have been approved for the generic catalogue numbers are now listed in the APL. New manufacturers will be added as they apply and are approved.
- ◆ Products are now grouped together by type and manufacturer for ease of searching.
- ◆ There have been numerous changes to catalogue numbers. Please see the list of changes included at the back of the APL.
- ◆ Catalogue numbers were deleted when they have been inactive for the last three years and there is a generic catalogue number available.
- ◆ AADL will host Q&A sessions regarding Seating Updates on the following dates:

 - ◆ Thursday May 1, 2014 11 am to 12 pm
