## **Process to Become a Seating Authorizer**

Effective immediately, the process to become an AADL Seating Authorizer has been updated:

To become an AADL Seating Authorizer, complete the <u>application form</u>. The form will require the following information:

- ◆ Date the online **AADL Seating Module** was completed.
- ◆ Request for E-business access.
- ◆ Information regarding clinical experience with seating. This will include information about current employment and previous clinical experience.
- Information about continuing education for seating.
- ◆ Information about technical education for seating components.
- Case study of an actual seating client.

AADL will review submitted applications and assign product ranges for seating benefits to approved authorizers.
