Wheelchair Accessories and Seating Benefit Update

Effective Oct 1, 2016 AADL will be combining the Wheelchair Accessories (V) and Seating Benefits (X) approved product lists.

- The new approved product list will utilize generic catalogue numbers with benchmark prices.
- Equipment provided using the generic catalogue numbers must meet the minimum standards and be provided from an approved manufacturer.
- There will be no change to the type of benefits available. All current products will continue to be available.

For Authorizers

• In the coming months AADL will be seeking feedback on the new approved product list.

For Vendors

• All current and new seating vendors will be required to have a new agreement.

For Manufacturers

- There are several manufacturers already listed as approved manufactures for seating. These
 manufacturers are listed in the current Seating Benefits Approved Product list (<u>http://
 www.health.alberta.ca/documents/AADL-Manual-X-Products.pdf</u>)
 - Manufacturers listed here do not need to apply again.
