Profile of the Alberta Public Service

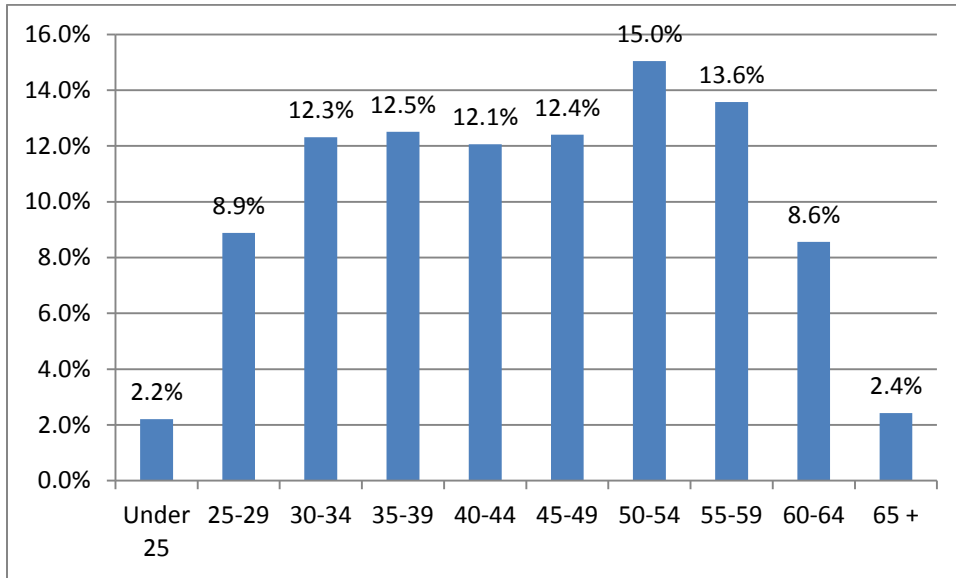
As of March 31, 2015 there were 27,643 employees in the Alberta Public Service, an increase over March 31, 2014 when there were 27,149 employees.

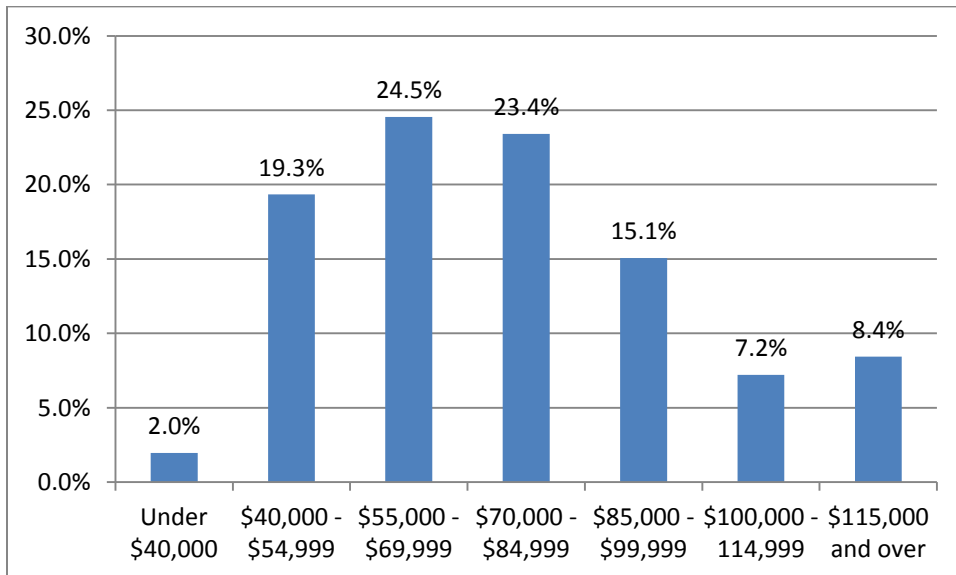
Age Distribution

Average employee age: 45.4

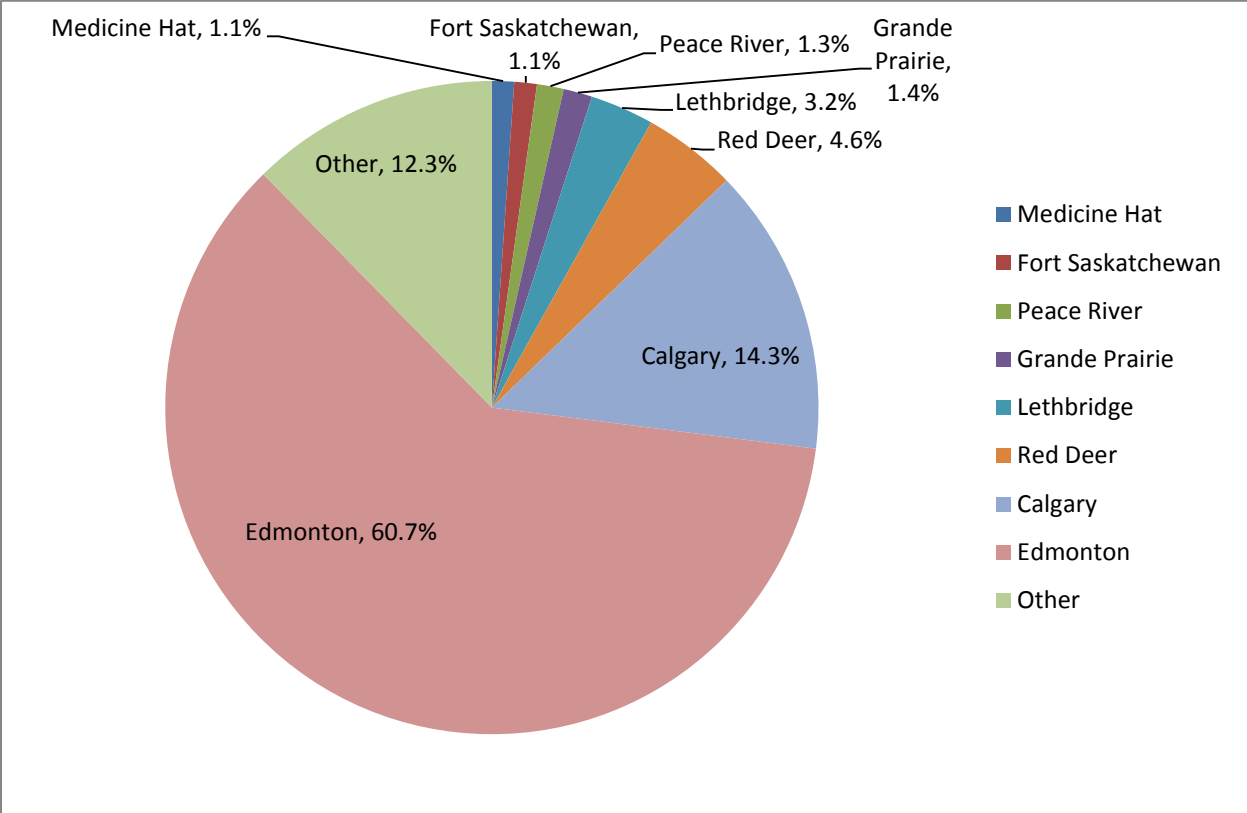


Salary Distribution
