

Law Enforcement Review Board hearings – June 2017

June 2, 2017

The Law Enforcement Review Board will hear final arguments on the following appeals:

Edmonton: Oxford Tower, 15th Flr, 10025-102 A Avenue

June 6, 2017 (9 a.m.)

- Mr. T. Anderson filed complaints alleging an officer was unnecessarily aggressive with him over the telephone, including threatening to charge him without hearing his side of the story. He also alleged the officer did not call him back when she said she would, leaving him uncertain about the status of any charges.

June 8, 2017 (9 a.m.)

- Mr. D. Steinbrenner filed a complaint alleging an officer failed to properly safeguard his personal property when he was arrested.

An independent body established pursuant to the *Police Act* in 1973, the Alberta Law Enforcement Review Board reviews public complaints about police officer conduct. The board also reviews police officers' appeals on disciplinary action.
