- Mr. and Mrs. Szybunka filed complaints arising from the death of their son. In particular, they allege the officer did not provide proper care and due diligence in the handling of their son, who was issued a ticket for public intoxication and died shortly after he was released by the officer.

An independent body established pursuant to the *Police Act* in 1973, the Alberta Law Enforcement Review Board reviews public complaints about police officer conduct. The board also reviews police officers' appeals on disciplinary action.
