 AZ initially filed complaints alleging officers committed misconduct while responding to a call involving an incident at a high school. Upon hearing, the Board directed a disciplinary hearing for one of the officers. AZ is appealing the Presiding Officer's decision arising from the disciplinary hearing.

May 11, 2017 (9:30 a.m.) Courtroom 3

• EF filed complaints alleging discreditable conduct and unlawful or unnecessary exercise of authority against officers who dealt with his son.
