

Law Enforcement Review Board – December 2017

December 12, 2017 (9:30 a.m.)

The Minister of Justice and Solicitor General has directed the board, under section 17 of the *Police Act*, to conduct an inquiry into whether any person or entity with responsibilities in connection with policing (including public oversight) did, or omitted to do anything to interfere with, obstruct or avoid disciplinary action under the *Police Act*, relating to the conduct of Calgary Police Service officers in connection with the arrest of Jason Arkinstall on or about Aug. 31 2008 in Calgary, Alberta.

The board will conduct a pre-inquiry meeting, open to the media and others, to hear submissions from possible participants on what processes the LERB might consider in conducting the inquiry.

If necessary, the pre-inquiry meeting will continue on Dec. 13, 2017 at the same location and the same start time.

The initial inquiry hearing is tentatively scheduled for February 2018.

An independent body established pursuant to the *Police Act* in 1973, the Alberta Law Enforcement Review Board reviews public complaints about police officer conduct. The board also reviews police officers' appeals on disciplinary action.
