**Subject: Cody Mason Demary – Public Fatality Inquiry
Response to Recommendation**

Please find enclosed a copy of the Honourable Judge D.G. Rae's report to the Minister of Justice and Solicitor General. This report will be publicly released on March 14, 2018.

The following recommendation made by His Honour may impact Transportation:

That *Alberta Vehicle Inspection Regulation, Alberta Regulation 211/2006* be reviewed to give consideration of the inclusion of back-up alarms as part of the required annual inspection.

I ask that you please advise the following:

1. Whether Transportation accepts, accepts in principle, rejects, or has a different response to the recommendation;
2. A brief explanation of why that decision was made; and
3. If Transportation intends to accept the recommendation, or to implement different measures, what steps will be taken in that respect.

A response to this enquiry is not mandatory. However, be advised that any response received will be publicly released and posted on the Open Government Portal:
