
## Alberta Traffic Collisions - Driver Error 2012



In 2012, 87.9% of total collisions involved one or more drivers identified as committing a driver error.

Other factors which contributed to the 136,595 reported collisions in 2012 were:

**Driver condition** – 3.4 per cent of total collisions involved one or more drivers identified as having a physical condition that contributed to the collision. 24.8 per cent of fatal collisions involved one or more drivers with a physical condition, which contributed to the collision.

**Speed** – 6.8 per cent of total collisions involved one or more drivers indicated by the police as having been travelling at a speed too great for the given conditions. However, 27.4 per cent of fatal collisions involved unsafe speed.

**Vehicle condition** – Only 0.7 per cent of total collisions involved one or more vehicles identified as having a vehicle defect which contributed to the collision.

Driver Condition includes: had been drinking, impaired by alcohol/drugs, fatigued/asleep or medical defect.

Note: \*Does not include counter reported property damage only collisions.
