
Alberta Traffic Collisions - Driver Error 2010



In 2010, 90.7% of total collisions involved one or more drivers identified as committing a driver error.

Other factors which contributed to the 151289 reported collisions in 2010 were:

- Driver condition 3.3 per cent of total collisions involved one or more drivers identified as having a physical condition that contributed to the collision (i.e., had been drinking, impaired by alcohol/drugs, fatigued/asleep or medical defect).
 33.2 per cent of fatal collisions involved one or more drivers with a physical condition, which contributed to the collision.
- Speed 5.9 per cent of total collisions involved one or more drivers indicated by the police as having been travelling at a speed too great for the given conditions. However, 26.7 per cent of fatal collisions involved unsafe speed.
- Vehicle condition Only 0.6 per cent of total collisions involved one or more vehicles identified as having a vehicle defect which contributed to the collision.
