Please note: Alberta announced the first case of COVID-19 on March 5 and declared a public health state of emergency on March 17, 2020. All non-essential businesses were asked to close on March 27, 2020. Alberta's phased relaunch began on May 14, 2020. All Parks Canada facilities were temporarily closed from March 25, 2020, and opened for day use on June 1, 2020. All provincial parks closed on March 17 and reopened on May 14, 2020. The Royal Alberta Museum and Royal Tyrrell Museum opened on May 16 and 22, respectively while another five historical sites opened on June 20, 2020. A second public health state of emergency was declared on November 24, 2020.

5. Accommodation Indices for Major Regions - Occupancy rates and average daily room rates are based on monthly averages of all reporting hotels, motels and motor hotels in each designated region. Alberta Resorts includes the resort communities of Banff, Lake Louise, Kananaskis, Canmore and Jasper.

Revenue per available room is calculated using the occupancy rate and average daily room rate.
