
Student Population by Grade and School Year, Alberta

- Starting with the 2013/2014 school year, the definition of an Alberta student is an individual who is registered as of September 30th of the school year in a school located in Alberta, where "school" means a structured learning environment through which an education program is offered to a student by: a board (includes public, separate, Francophone, Lloydminster); an operator of a private school; an early childhood services (ECS) program private operator; the operator of a charter school; a parent giving a home education program; the Minister. It also includes other Alberta-located educational institutions providing ECS to Grade 12 curriculum instruction, specifically Federal (First Nations schools and those operated by Corrections Canada); and provincial authorities (such as Bow Valley College and NorQuest College).
- A new student information system came online for the 2013/2014 school year. As part of the new system, more efficient
 and accurate processes for collecting student data were instituted and historical student enrolment data was converted to
 reflect these new processes. Student population information from previous years has been restated.
