## **Wetland Plant Categories**

Category	Examples	Description
Emergent	Reed grass, common cattail, bulrush, marsh marigold, small-flowered buttercup and giant bur-reed	Vegetation with roots in water, but grows well above the surface, and most often close to the water's edge or in shallower areas.
Submergent	Coontail, northern watermilfoil, Richardson pondweed, whitestem pondweed and white water buttercup	Plants that are completely underwater. Their stems are floppy because the water holds them up. Always underwater, they change position with the water level.
Floating	Common duckweed, star duckweed, small yellow pond lily, floating leaf pondweed and water smartweed	Plants whose leaves float at the surface and roots hang down. Often, they have pockets of air that help them to stay afloat, such as bladderwort.
