
Alberta Official Statistics

Average Weekly Earnings (including overtime), Alberta

- The average weekly earnings¹ are derived by dividing total weekly earnings for the month by the number of employees.
- In November 2023, average weekly earnings for Albertans increased by 0.6% from the previous month to \$1,301.
- Between November 2022 and November 2023, Alberta saw a 2.2% increase in its average weekly earnings, whereas Canada overall posted an increase of 4.1%.
- Average weekly earnings advanced in November to a new all-time high.
- Average weekly earnings in Alberta are 4.4% higher than the next highest province and 5.9% higher than the national average.
