WHEREAS on July 13, 2018, the Parties' consultant submitted to the Director the *Water Act* Remedial Plan;

WHEREAS on October 23, 2018, in response to a further information request by the Director, the Parties' consultant submitted to the Director an Interim Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan for Ditch A.

THEREFORE, I, Todd Letwin, pursuant to section 135(1) and 136(1) of the *Act*, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. The Parties shall implement the Interim Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan for Ditch A on or before November 5, 2018.
2. The Parties shall complete all of the work set out in the Interim Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan for Ditch A by November 21, 2018.
3. The Parties shall, by November 21, 2018 submit to the Director written confirmation of the completion of all of the work set out in the Interim Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan for Ditch A.
4. The Parties shall, at least once per week between April 1 and June 1, 2019, monitor the water at the outlet of Ditch A in accordance with all of the requirements set out in the Table below:

Table 1 - Release Limits and Monitoring Requirements

Parameter	Release Limit	Sample Type
Total Suspended Solids	100 milligrams per litre	Grab sample
pH	6.0 to 9.5 units	Grab sample
Hydrocarbons	No visible sheen	Visual observation

5. The Parties shall immediately report in writing to the Director of

- (a) all exceedances of all limits set out in Table 1 above; and
- (b) recommendations for measures that will bring the parameters within the limits set out in Table 1 above.
