ASIRT investigation into fatal RCMP officer-involved shooting concluded

The Alberta Serious Incident Response Team (ASIRT) has completed its investigation into an incident and released the assistant executive director's full report.

On Sept. 23, 2019, pursuant to Sec. 46.1 of the *Police Act*, ASIRT was directed to investigate a fatal RCMP officer-involved shooting in Strathcona County. ASIRT's investigation is now complete.

ASIRT's mandate is to effectively, independently and objectively investigate incidents involving Alberta's police that have resulted in serious injury or death to any person, as well as serious or sensitive allegations of police misconduct.
