

What is “a licence in good standing?”

Only water allocations under a licence in good standing may be transferred. A licence must be in good standing in order to divert water.

Examples of when Alberta Environment does **not** consider a licence to be in good standing:

When the licence is:

- In breach of the *Water Act*
- Subject to an investigation under the Water Act
- Subject to an enforcement tool or prosecution
- In breach of terms and conditions of the licence.
