## Institution Related Notes (2022-23 year):

- 1. The institutional changes of Red Deer Polytechnic (formerly Red Deer College) in 2021-22 and Northwestern Polytechnic (formerly Grande Prairie Regional College) in 2022-23 caused these institutions to move from the Comprehensive Community Colleges sector into the Polytechnic Institutions sector. To enable longitudinal reporting, they have been reported with their new names in the Polytechnic sector for all years in this table.
- 2. A number of institutions updated their fiscal reporting year which required changes to the LERS reporting period moving from a July-June to a May-April reporting year. To account for longitudinal reporting, the transition year re-reported the spring session enrolments from the prior year, so the year of the change would continue to have a 12 month reporting period. Mount Royal University, Northern Alberta Institute of Technology, and Southern Alberta Institute of Technology made this transition in the 2021-22 LERS reporting year, while Lakeland College and Northwestern Polytechnic transitioned in the 2022-23 LERS reporting year.
- 3. Both the University of Alberta (UA) and Northern Alberta Institute of Technology went through a reporting cleanup where the full load values of their programming (UA was undergraduate level only) were standardized. These reporting changes created an artificial increase in reported FLE which is not proportionate to the actual enrolment changes. Any longitudinal FLE analysis should be used with caution for the system, as well as the affected sectors and institutions.
- 4. In 2021-22 and 2022-23, Portage College includes enrolments related to private partnership agreements. The inclusion of these enrolments result in significant increases in both FLE and learners reported in these years. With the college teaching out these programs, it is expected that these enrolments will decline over the next year.

## Notes:

- Values listed in the above table represent the number of Unique Students at the level you are looking at, and therefore summing up corresponding rows may lead to an over-inflated value. For example, a student attending both Athabasca University and the University of Alberta will be counted once in each corresponding row, but will also only be counted once when looking at the Comprehensive Academic and Research Universities sector total.
  - Full Time students are those students that were actively enrolled in at least 60% of a full course load. If, for the academic year, a student generated 0.6 FLEs or greater, they are considered Full-Time.
  - Part Time students are those students that were actively enrolled in less than 60% of full course load for the academic year.
- The data in these tables are limited to provincially-approved programming at publicly-funded post-secondary institutions in Alberta. The Banff Centre does not offer standardized approved programming and therefore enrolments at The Banff Centre are not included in these datasets.
- To allow for longitudinal analysis, we have used the current institutional names rather than have multiple names for an institution for various years.
