WHEREAS Environmental Protection Order No. EPO-2019/01-UAR ("the "EPO") was issued to the Parties on October 24, 2019;

WHEREAS Clause 2 of the EPO required the Parties to submit to the Director by October 31, 2019, the name and qualifications of a professional holding a designation listed in the Professional Responsibilities in Completion and Assurance of Reclamation and Remediation Work in Alberta Joint Practice Standard (v1.1 July 2012);

WHEREAS the Parties had a discussion with the Director on October 30, 2019 regarding the limitations they were experiencing in retaining a professional in accordance with Clause 2 of the EPO, specifically the timelines associated with getting a contract in place to fulfill compliance with the EPO:

WHEREAS the Parties emailed the Director on October 30, 2019, requesting an extension to find a professional required to meet Clause 2 of the EPO;

WHEREAS the Director contacted the Parties on October 31, 2019, and confirmed the request to extend Clause 2 of the EPO to November 15, 2019 and to extend the other timelines stated in the EPO to one month from the original dates;

WHEREAS I Owen Butz, Compliance Manager, Upper Athabasca Region have been appointed a Director for the purposes of issuing and amending Environmental Protection Orders under the *Act*;

WHEREAS the Director is of the opinion that the EPO must be amended to reflect the new deadlines;

THEREFORE, I, Owen Butz, Director, Upper Athabasca Region, pursuant to section 243 (1)(a) of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, DO HEREBY AMEND the EPO and ORDER THAT:

- 1. In Clause 2, "October 31, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "November 15, 2019";
- 2. In Clause 3, "November 14, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "December 12, 2019";
- 3. In Clause 3(e), "November 21, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "December 19", 2019";
- 4. In Clause 4, "November 21, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "December 19, 2019";
- 5. In Clause 5, "December 21, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "January 16, 2020";
- 6. In Clause 6, "October 31, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "November 21, 2019";
- 7. In Clause 6(c), "November 14, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "December 5, 2019";
- 8. In Clause 7, "November 14, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "December 5, 2019";
- 9. In Clause 8, "December 14, 2019" is deleted and replaced with "January 16, 2020";
