

# Glossary of Terms

## Cultural Industry Book Publishers Operating Grant Program

Term	Description
<b>Affiliated Organization</b>	A group of organizations in which the same person, group of persons, or entity holds the majority of shares with full voting rights or has control in fact of these companies.
<b>Author Subsidized Title</b>	Is a title whose author pays for the cost of designing, printing, and distributing their book. Self-published books are the property of the author and usually remain in the author's possession; all sales proceeds belong to the author.
<b>Children's Book</b>	A book published for the children's or young adults' markets, including picture books, easy-to-read books, chapter books and young adult books. Educational books intended for elementary school students are also considered children's books. Teacher's guides and books of reproducible material are not considered eligible children's books.
<b>Editorial Independence</b>	Organizations will be considered editorially independent if their publisher and/or editor do not share time in any way with other affiliated organizations, and if they do not make use of the time of the publisher and/or editor of another affiliated organization.
<b>Eligible Title</b>	A title that is at least 48 pages in length for a printed book, except for children's books, which can be less than 48 pages; or a digital version of a book, including an audio version that is the equivalent to the above requirements for a printed book and is available for sale through the internet or by any other non-physical transmission. Must be a new title or new edition.
<b>Eligible Title Sales Revenue</b>	The sales revenue derived from the sales of an Eligible Title.
<b>New Title</b>	The publication, in modified form, of a book previously published by the same or a different publisher. A new edition must have substantial changes to at least 25 per cent of the original content or at least 25 per cent new written content; or substantial changes to the illustrations (excluding the cover).
<b>Self-Published Title</b>	A publication with at least one author who is a shareholder or an owner of the publishing firm.
