

**DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
REGISTRAR'S EXEMPTION**

The Director of Vehicle Safety, Alberta Transportation, pursuant to section 40(1) of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation AR121/2009, subject to the conditions and restrictions noted below, hereby exempts the carrier and driver of a commercial vehicle, for the purposes of conducting a road-test, from the requirements to:

- a) Carry or produce the applicable schedule of the NSC Standard 13, Part 2 as required by the Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation AR121/2009 subsections 10(9) and (11), and
- b) Prepare, carry, or produce a trip inspection report as required by the Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation subsections 12(2), (5) and (6).

**Conditions:**

1. The commercial vehicle is being road-tested, for the purposes of conducting an inspection or performing repairs, within 30 kilometres of the repair facility where the driver is employed.
2. The driver of the commercial vehicle holds a trade certificate, or is an apprentice, as defined in Alberta's *Apprenticeship and Industry Training Act*, in the trade of:
  - a) Automotive Service Technician,
  - b) Heavy Equipment Technician, or
  - c) Truck and Transport Mechanic, or
  - d) Transport-Trailer Mechanic.
3. All property damage collisions in excess of \$2,000, fatalities and serious injuries shall be reported to the Registrar within 24 hours of the incident, and all reporting to the Registrar can be made via email, or written notice to:

4. A copy of this exemption must be carried in the vehicle and produced on demand of a peace officer.
5. This exemption may be amended, suspended, or cancelled at any time.

This exemption expires on December 1, 2022.
