**ORDER TO VACATE**

**Pursuant to Section 47.1 of the *Public Lands Act*  
*RSA 2000, c. P-40, as amended***

WHEREAS the land described as Legal Subdivisions 13 and 14 within the North West Quarter of Section 31, Township 51, Range 24, West of the 5<sup>th</sup> Meridian near the Town of Hinton, in the Province of Alberta, [the "Lands"] are "public lands" within the meaning of section 1(p) of the *Public Lands Act*; and are represented in Appendix A of this Order;

WHEREAS section 20 of the *Public Lands Act* states that no person shall enter on and occupy any public land for any purpose unless authorized by Alberta Environment and Parks ("AEP");

WHEREAS AEP has never authorized Brandon Scott Mead to enter on and occupy the Lands for any purpose;

WHEREAS on May 15, 2020, the EPO and an AEP Lands Officer observed the Lands and noted the following on a routine patrol where the EPO left a random camping notice on a motorhome (license plate # CCH-9869);

WHEREAS on May 18, 2020, the EPO and an AEP Conservation Officer observed Brandon Scott Mead occupying the Lands and informed the EPO that he had been occupying the Lands since the winter;

WHEREAS Brandon Scott Mead is unlawfully occupying the Lands and is a Trespasser;

WHEREAS section 47.1 of the *Public Lands Act* provides that where a person unlawfully occupies public land, the director may order the person to vacate the public land;

WHEREAS section 62(10) of the *Public Lands Act* provides that the Director may by notice in writing advise a person to remove chattels from public land and if that notice is not complied with the chattels may be confiscated and disposed of;

WHEREAS Jack McNaughton, Compliance Manager, Boreal Northwest Region, Alberta Environment and Parks, has been designated as a director under the *Public Lands Act* for the purposes of issuing orders to vacate (the "Director");

THEREFORE, I, Jack McNaughton, the Director, pursuant to section 47.1 of the *Public Lands Act*, DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:

1. Brandon Scott Mead shall forthwith vacate the Lands;
2. Prior to vacating, Brandon Scott Mead shall immediately remove from the Lands:
  - a) all improvements, structures, personal property, chattels, including but not limited to any material piles on or under the Lands;
  - b) All waste and debris
3. On or before June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Brandon Scott Mead shall provide notice to AEP of the completion of the removal required by paragraph 2 above. Verbal Notice shall be provided to the Director via telephone at 780-624-6551.
