Bargaining Update is a monthly report that provides information about the unionized workforce, primarily in Alberta.

In November 2015, Mediation Services received settlement information regarding 40 bargaining relationships encompassing 3,853 employees. There were 34 private sector and 6 public sector settlements, covering 1,733 and 2,120 employees respectively.

Highlights

Calgary Laboratory Services

Calgary Laboratory Services and the Health Sciences Association of Alberta, representing 1,640 employees, have reached a thirty-six month collective agreement which will expire on June 30, 2017.

City of Calgary

The City of Calgary has requested the establishment of a Compulsory Arbitration Board to settle the dispute with 1,496 firefighters represented by the International Association of Firefighters Local 255. The firefighters have been working without a collective agreement since January 2014.

Associated Ambulance & Services (Whitecourt) Ltd.

Associated Ambulance and CUPE Local 4351 have jointly requested the establishment of a Compulsory Arbitration Board to resolve their collective bargaining dispute. The collective agreement covering 55 employees expired on March 41, 2014.

Average Weekly Earnings Alberta (AWEA)*



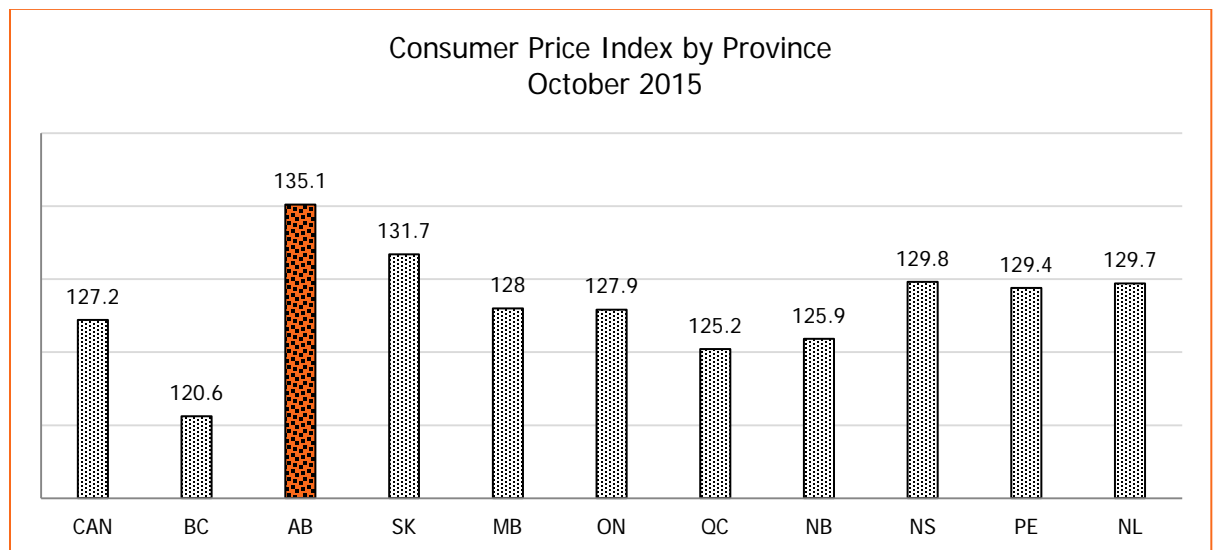
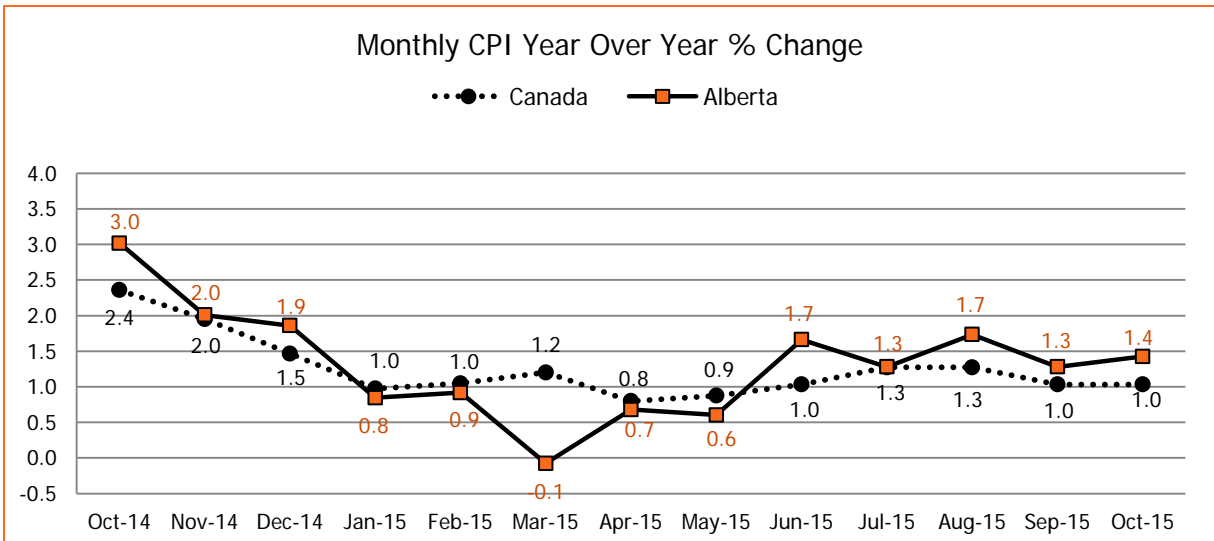
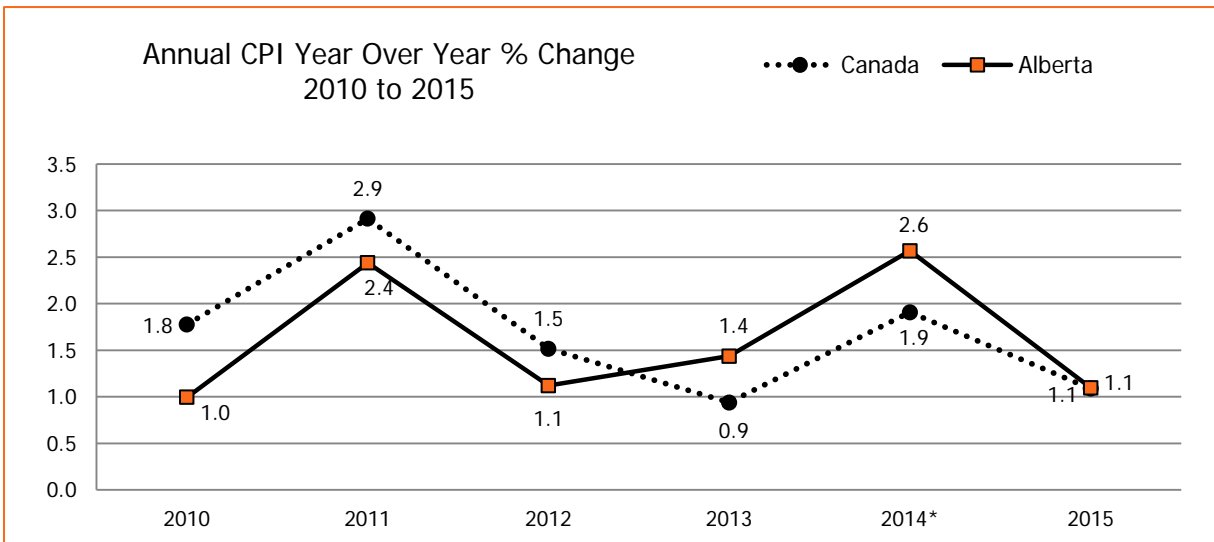

Consumer Price Index (CPI), 2002=100



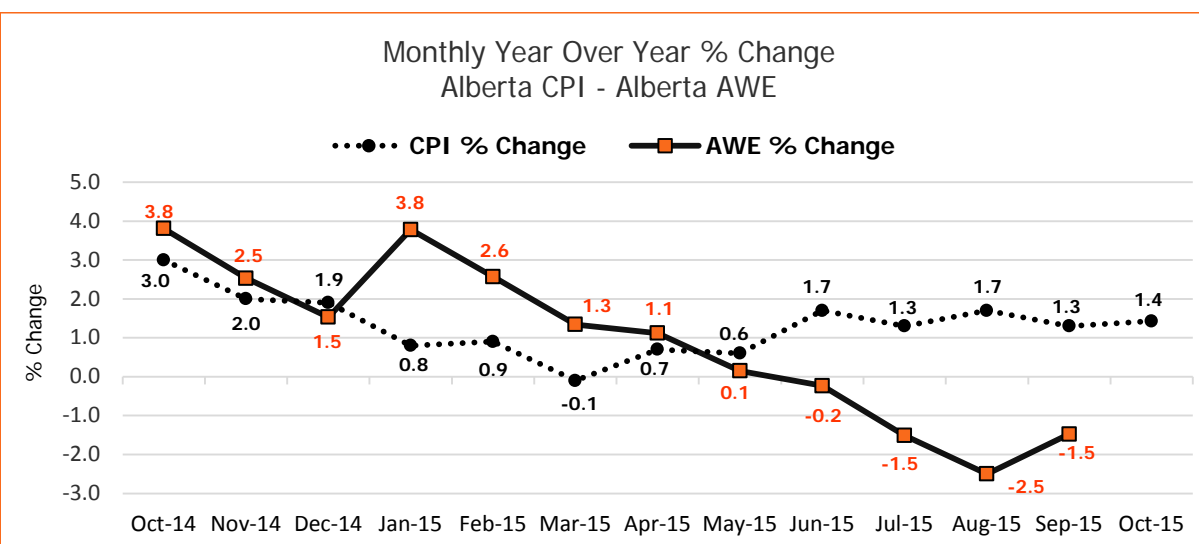
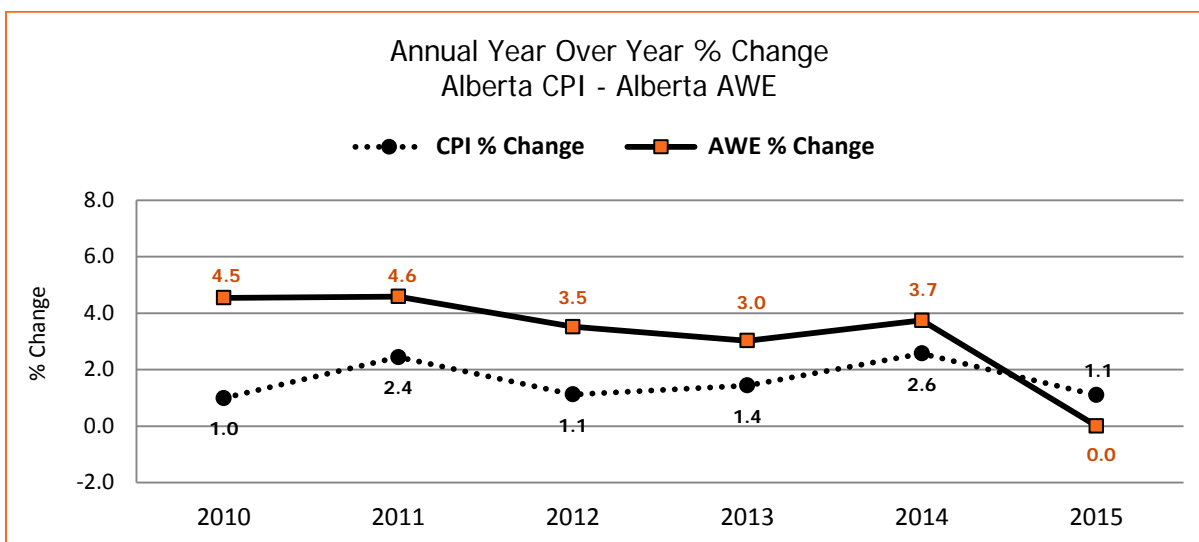
