Edmonton appeal:

- Jeremy Doucet is appealing the decision by the Edmonton chief of police to dismiss his complaint regarding his experience with Edmonton Police Service officers at an Edmonton bar.

Calgary appeal:

March 27, 2024 (9:30 a.m.)

- Roopa Wickson is appealing the presiding officer's decision on a penalty issued to a Calgary Police Service officer at a disciplinary hearing.

The Law Enforcement Review Board, an independent body established under the *Police Act* in 1973, reviews public complaints about police officer conduct and appeals from police officers on disciplinary action.
