ENFORCEMENT ORDER NO. WA-EO-33359

R & A Harpe Holdings Ltd. Box 137 Valhalla Centre, Alberta T0H 3M0 (Hereinafter referred to as "the Company")

WHEREAS Enforcement Order No. WA-EO-33359 [The "EO"] was issued to the Company on February 5, 2021;

WHEREAS based on events that have occurred since the EO was issued on February 5, 2021, the Director is of the opinion that an amendment of the EO is necessary;

WHEREAS Jack McNaughton, Alberta Environment and Parks ("AEP") Compliance Manager, North Region has been appointed a Director for the purposes of issuing and amending enforcement orders under the *Act* (the "Director");

THEREFORE, I, Jack McNaughton, the Director, pursuant to sections 137(1)(a) of the *Water Act*, DO HEREBY AMEND THE EO AND ORDER:

- 1. Clauses 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 11 of the EO are hereby deleted, cancelled or repealed, as the case may be.
- 2. Clause 8 is amended to state the following:

The Company shall complete the remedial works, with a completion date of no later than August 1, 2021 (the "Completion Date").

3. Clause 9 is amended to state the following:

The Company shall undertake remedial works that render the ditches ineffective by returning the excavated soils to the ditches as shown in Schedule 1.

4. Clause 10 is amended to state the following:

The Company shall provide the Director with 1 days' notice either by phone or email prior to commencing the remedial work.
