

High Risk Individuals – Refer to Public Health for Immunization

Special consideration and careful assessment prior to immunizing is required for the following groups of individuals:

- **Individuals with chronic health conditions and/or certain medical conditions** – may be eligible for additional vaccines
- **Immunocompromised individuals** – some vaccines may be contraindicated
- **Individuals who have received blood products within the previous year** – may require additional spacing between blood product and live vaccine

Chronic Health/Medical Conditions to Consider (This is NOT an all inclusive list)
