

Labour Force Statistics Aboriginal People (Off-Reserve) February 2011

Alberta Aboriginal People Highlights:

- The unadjusted three-month moving average unemployment rate for Aboriginal People living off-reserve was 8.7% in February 2011, lower by 0.3 percentage points from the previous month and by 7.6 percentage points from the same month last year.
- Between February 2010 and February 2011, employment increased by 4,300 and unemployment decreased by 6,600.
- Year-over-year, the unemployment rate for Aboriginal men decreased by 6.6 percentage points and by 8.8 percentage points for women.
- Between February 2010 and February 2011, the unemployment rate for Aboriginal People decreased 7.3 percentage points in Edmonton, 7.7 percentage points in Calgary, and 7.3 points in the rest of Alberta.
- Between January 2011 and February 2011, employment increased in the following industries: Retail and Wholesale Trade 700; Educational Services 500; and Information, Culture and Recreation 100.
