

Labour Force Statistics Aboriginal People (Off-Reserve) July 2011

Alberta Aboriginal People Highlights:

- The unadjusted three-month moving average unemployment rate for Aboriginal People living off-reserve was 13.7% in July 2011, lower than the 15.3% reported in the previous month.
- Employment in July was 2,800 higher than a month ago for Aboriginal people and 2,000 lower than the same month last year.
- Full-time employment increased by 2,000 and part-time employment rose by 800 from the previous month.
- Between June and July, the unemployment rate for Aboriginal People in Calgary fell 2.8 percentage points to 10.4%, as the provincial average unemployment rate for Aboriginal People declined 1.6 percentage points to 13.7%.
- In July, employment gains were noted in four occupational groups for Aboriginal People living off-reserve: Sales and service, by 1,800; Business, finance and administrative, by 1,600; Occupations unique to processing, manufacturing and utilities, by 1,000; and Natural and applied sciences and related, by 800.
