

Labour Force Statistics Aboriginal People (Off-Reserve) March 2011

Alberta Aboriginal People Highlights:

- The unadjusted three-month moving average unemployment rate for Aboriginal People living off-reserve was 9.9% in March 2011, higher by 1.2 percentage points from the previous month and lower by 7.4 percentage points from the same month last year.
- While Aboriginal people's labour force decreased by 1,000, employment decreased by 1,900.
- Year-over-year, employment for Aboriginal people increased by 2,900 and unemployment decreased by 6,500.
- The unemployment rate for Aboriginal men increased by 2.5 percentage points to 13.1% and for Aboriginal women decreased by 0.5 percentage points to 5.9% from the previous month.
- Between February 2011 and March 2011, employment increased the most in the following industries: Retail and Wholesale Trade, 1,100; Construction, 1,000; and Manufacturing, 300.
