Labour Force Statistics Aboriginal People (Off-Reserve) September 2011

Alberta Aboriginal People Highlights:

- The unadjusted three-month moving average unemployment rate for Aboriginal People living off-reserve was 11.5% in September 2011, lower than the previous month by 0.8 percentage points and lower by 1.2 percentage points from the same month last year.
- The Aboriginal people labour force increased in September by 1,500 and employment rose by 1,900.
- The unemployment rate declined from 11.9% to 10.4% for Aboriginal men; and rose slightly, from 12.7% to 12.8% for Aboriginal women.
- Full-time employment and part-time employment were both higher in September, by 1,600 and 300 respectively, compared to August 2011.
- While employment for Aboriginal People decreased by 100 in Edmonton and Calgary respectively between August and September, employment increased by 2,300 in the rest of Alberta.
