WHEREAS a Public Inquiry was held at the Provincial Court of Alberta
in the City (City, Town, etc.) of Calgary (Name of City, Town, etc.)
on the 9th day of December, 1996 (and by adjournment

A. P. Demong, a Provincial Court Judge.

A jury was was not summoned and an Inquiry was held into the death of
Michael Jack McNallie (Name in Full) 21 (Age) years
of 159 Erin Road S.E., Calgary, Alberta (Residence) and the following findings were made:
Date and Time of Death June 27, 1996 at 0227 hours
Place Bow Valley Centre, Calgary General Hospital

Medical Cause of Death ("cause of death" means the medical cause of death according to the International Statistical Classification of Diseases, Injuries and Causes of Death as last revised by the International Conference assembled for that purpose and published by the World Health Organization — The Fatality Inquiries Act, Section 1(d))
Anoxic Brain Injury due to hanging.

Manner of Death ("manner of death" means the mode or method of death whether natural, homicidal, suicidal, accidental or undeterminable — The Fatality Inquiries Act, Section 1(g))
Suicidal

CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH DEATH OCCURRED

Michael Jack McNallie was admitted to the Forensic Unit of the Calgary
General Hospital, Bow Valley Centre for an assessment as a result of charges
he faced before the court. Mr. McNallie was placed on constant observation,
which was later reduced to close observation. It was at this time he signed
a contract agreeing not to do harm to himself. On June 25, 1996 at 0425
hours Mr. McNallie was found hanging in the bathroom. Following vigorous
resuscitation he was transferred to the ICU and eventually died at 0227
hours of June 27, 1996.


