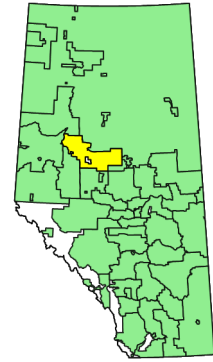


High Prairie School Div No. 48 highlighted in yellow.  
Authority boundaries as of September 07, 2015

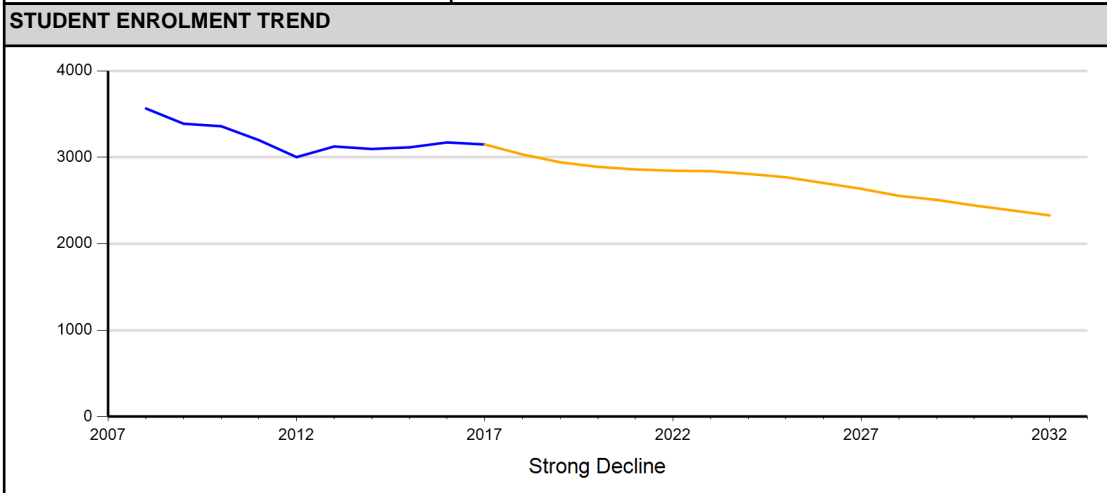
