There have been several public complaints regarding waste blowing from the landfill and accumulating on private property that has caused an impact. The Approval requires the City to submit an updated Operation Plan to include the "procedures for the management and control of litter". The plan wa submitted in July of 2000 and on 1 February 2001, the City submitted a Draft Litter Control Plan, but it was deficient. The City was advised to complete the Litter Control Plan and to submit it along with the finalized Operations Plan by 1 May 2002, the plans were not received. The City shall cease accepting waste for disposal at the landfill when wind speeds exceed an average of 60 kph over one-hour period, and instantaneous wind speeds exceed 75 kph twice in any one-hour period; submit a litter control plan to prevent the release of substance into the environment and implement the plan; submit written status reports; and submit a final written report detailing the work undertaken to comply with this order. |
