Re: CPOIP – Registration Now Open for May 23 – June 30, 2022 Course in Edmonton

Justice and Solicitor General Training Academy, in partnership with the City of Edmonton Community Standards and Neighbourhoods, will be offering a Community Peace Officer Induction Program (CPOIP) as follows:

May 23 – June 30, 2022

The course is for sponsored candidates currently employed by a peace officer agency or who have been offered employment contingent upon successful completion of training. There will be **10 spaces available**, on a first-come first-served basis.

Application form and fees:

- Fees: \$3800 (does not include accommodations and meals).
