Ministerial Order

104/85

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

Lots A, D, E and F, as shown upon a plan of survey of a subdivision on file in the Department of Energy and Natural Resources at Edmonton as No. 3159 Gen. and of record in the Land Titles Office at Edmonton for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Number 3111 T.R.

iv) Thirty-one and eight hundred seventy-three thousandths (31.873) hectares (78.76 acres), more or less, required for a subdivision, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the said Land Titles Office as No. 3885 N.Y.

C) The south half of the north west quarter of section 21, containing thirty-two and three hundred seventy-five thousandths (32.375) hectares (80.00 acres), more or less.

i) Six hundred seven thousandths (0.607) hectares (1.50 acres), more or less, required for a roadway, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the said Land Titles Office as No. 376 J.Y.

ii) Nine hundred ninety-one thousandths (0.991) hectares (2.45 acres), more or less, required for a roadway and extra road, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the said Land Titles Office as No. 5273 L.Z.

iii) Four hundred forty-five thousandths (0.445) hectares (1.10 acres), more or less, required for a roadway, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the said Land Titles Office as No. 4678 P.X.

Reserving unto Her Majesty all mines and minerals and the right to work the same.
