

2020 Update

Alberta's agri-food exports

- In 2020, Alberta exported **\$12.4 billion** in agri-food products.
- Alberta is the third largest exporting province in Canada after Saskatchewan and Ontario.
- Approximately 46 per cent of exports were primary agricultural products and 54 per cent were valueadded products.
- Of total agri-food exports, **74 per cent** went to the US, China, Japan, Mexico and South Korea combined.
- In the past 10 years (2011-2020), primary agricultural exports grew by **6.9 per cent** and value-added exports grew by **6.8 per cent** annually on average.
