Investigations concluded on three files

The Alberta Serious Incident Response Team (ASIRT) has completed its investigations into three separate incidents and released the executive director and assistant executive director's reports on them.

On July 25, 2019, pursuant to Sec. 46.1 of the *Police Act*, ASIRT was directed to investigate a Rocky Mountain House RCMP officer-involved shooting. ASIRT's investigation is now complete.

On Jan. 11, 2020, ASIRT was directed to investigate a Cold Lake RCMP officerinvolved shooting. ASIRT's investigation is now complete.

On Sept. 28, 2022, pursuant to the agreement between ASIRT and the Yukon government, ASIRT was directed to investigate a Whitehorse RCMP officer-involved shooting. ASIRT's investigation is now complete.
