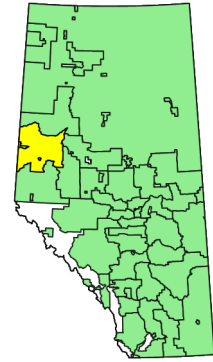


Peace Wapiti School Division highlighted in yellow.

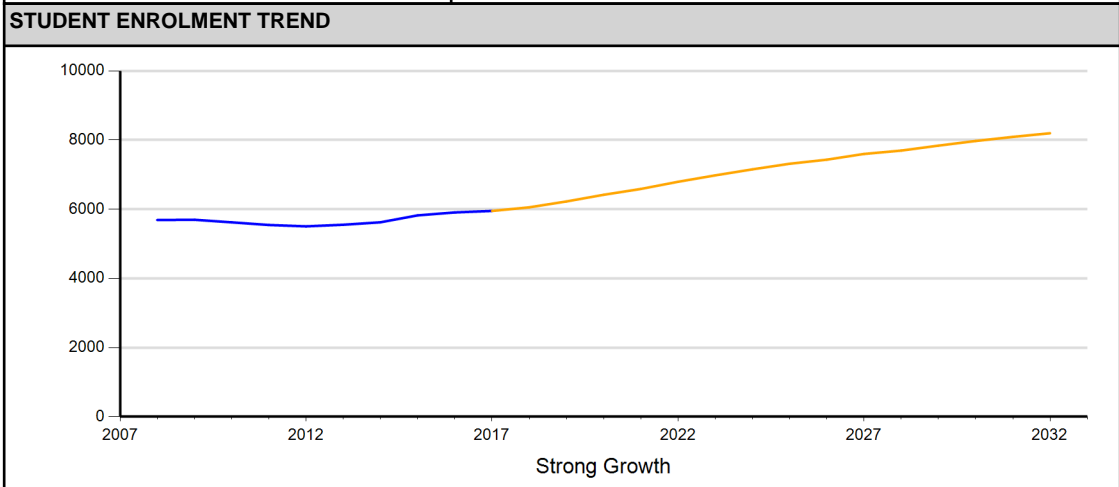
